Pollution Incident Response Management Plan Extract

Preamble

A Pollution Incident Response Management Plan must be prepared for all Projects based in NSW that hold an Environment Protection Licence (EPL), or for any project if directed to prepare one by the EPA.

It is a requirement under Clause 98D of the Protection of the Environment Operation Amendment Regulations 2012 that certain sections of the Plan are made publicly available on the website within 14 days after being prepared and approved for issue. The sections are those that cover procedures for contacting the relevant authorities and communicating with the community.

Section 6.12 and Appendix E of the Emergency Response Plan and Pollution Incident Response Management Plan for the Glenfield to Leppington Rail Line Project meet the requirements of Clause 98D and have been extracted and made available on the John Holland website.

Section 6.12 - Notification of Neighbouring residents and other land uses

If the Project Director in consultation with the Project Safety Manager and the Planning and Environment Manager determines that a pollution incident requires notification of surrounding premises and residents, this notification will be co-ordinated by the Community Relations Manager.

The area to be notified will be determined by the Project Safety Manager and the Planning and Environment Manager in consultation with the Community Relations Manager. The preferred method for early warning shall be door knock under taken as soon as practicable, with written letters used to provide any additional information.

Notification of surrounding residents and other land uses may also be undertaken at the direction of Emergency Services Site Controller, the EPA or the Ministry of Health.

APPENDIX E PROCEDURE FOR NOTIFYING AGENCIES OF A POLLUTION INCIDENT IF THERE IS A RISK OF MATERIAL HARM TO THE ENVIRONMENT

¹ Determine the Local Government Area(s) relevant to the incident and only notify relevant Council(s). ² Although the EPA's Incident Notification Protocol identifies 000 as the contact number for Fire and Rescue NSW, JH has been advised that the number listed here should be used for pollution incident notifications and that 000 must only be used for emergency calls.			

When notifying authorities that a pollution incident has occurred, the following information must be provided

- a) The time, date, nature, duration and location of the incident
- b) The location of the place where pollution is occurring or is likely to occur
- c) The nature, the estimated quantity or volume and the concentration of any pollutants involved, if known
- d) The circumstances in which the incident occurred (including the cause of the incident, if known)
- e) The action taken or proposed to be taken to deal with the incident and any resulting pollution or threatened pollution, if known

The information required is the information known to the person notifying the incident when the notification is required to be given.

If the information required to be included in a notice of a pollution incident under items (c), (d) or (e) is not known when the initial notification is made but becomes known afterwards, that information must be notified immediately after it becomes known.
